Tournament Bowlers/Coordinators: You are now invited to participate in our 43rd ANNUAL Q. Jamerson handicap tournament consisting of doubles, teams, all events, mixed doubles, and optional singles. On THURSDAY, The 9-Pin Tap will have 1 squad,; as well as 1 squad for mixed doubles & doubles (same night payout on the 9-Pin Tap). On FRIDAY, we will floor the 6-Game Sweeper (separate men & women and same night payout); in addition to RESERVED doubles/mixed doubles squad at 5 PM. On SATURDAY, we will floor men/women doubles-mixed doubles & Teams. On SUNDAY, we are asking everyone to **bring your best teams** to participate in the Battle of the "SHOWE ME" Teams with a 1-game handicap-based roll-off taking place immediately following the 12:00 NOON team squad on Sunday. Team Winners of the 1-game roll-off on Sunday will win (**sponsor donated \$500.00**) ... just another way of saying THANK YOU for your continued tournament participation. Scores bowled in Mixed Doubles will not be applied to All Events ... Entry fee is \$35.00 per person and \$20.00 per person for Optional Mixed Doubles Alibi. Mixed Doubles entries do not have to be prepaid ... No entry fee will be returned after entry has been scheduled ... **Entries close with Last Squad on June 25, 2023** ... All other rules governed by USBC and/or Q. Jamerson 2023 Rules.

Q. Jamerson 2023 Handicap Tournament Rules

(Arrive 45 minutes before squad time; squad sign up cut-off times will be 10 minutes before start of squad; squads will start on time)

***** TEAM ROLL-OFF:** Our sponsors are again donating an additional \$500.00 to the team event as an incentive for our Battle of the "Show Me" Team roll-off this year. The highest team scores bowled (with handicap) on the **12:00 NOON squad on Sunday, June 25, 2023**, will be eligible to compete for the 1-game team event roll-off to be held immediately following the Sunday 12 Noon squad, with the winning team of this 1-game roll-off taking home **\$500.00 that same day!** How this works: Each City will be eligible for (1) game team roll-off in the 12 o'clock team event on Sunday providing that the City is represented with a minimum of 2 teams, which must be PREPAID before the start of the tournament; members on the eligible team(s) **must have bowled in at least one other event of the tournament which was not a team event, excluding sweeper & 9-pin tap events.** There must be a minimum of 3 bowlers on a team from one certain City to represent that City; and eligible teams for the roll-off must be the same as original team lineup (no substitutions allowed in the roll-off). If an eligible team cannot produce the same team, then the next placed total pinfall team would be eligible for the roll-off. If an odd number in teams qualify, then the next highest represented City would be eligible for roll-off; maximum 6 teams in 1-game roll-off. The same rules apply to the Saturday high team \$250.00 payoff. The remainder of the prize list will be paid off in the usual manner, no later than 30 days following the tournament.

***** OPTIONAL SINGLES:** \$20.00 Initial Entry (for each 3-game set); \$10.00 Re-Entry. Separate payout for men and women division.

1. The tournament is open to all USBC certified bowlers. Touring pros are eligible to participate in this tournament with a maximum of 2 per team and only 1 of 2 for doubles event. Any entrant who does not hold or has not applied for USBC membership prior to bowling will be disqualified. USBC card \$27.00 for men and women.
2. Teams may consist of any mixed combination with a **team cap of 1100**. However, any team with a team average **exceeding 1050 will bowl scratch**; no handicap will be given. No more than 3 members on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. **Multiple entries are permitted in the five-player team event.** The first team score will count towards All Events. Team events must be prepaid.
3. There are separate prize funds in the Doubles events for men and women. Multiple entries are permitted in the Doubles events; however, the FIRST set of Doubles will count towards All Events. Bowler may cash only once with same partner; cash as often as partners are changed. (Rule 317, item b).
4. **AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS:** Bowlers must use last season's highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 games or more, If no average last year, use highest current season USBC sanctioned league average as of June 1, 2023, for 21 games or more, or 2022 summer league average, whichever is highest. An average of 210 will be used for bowlers with no established average. If current season average as of June 1, 2023, at time of bowling exceeds last season's (2021-2022) average by 10 pins or more, current season (as of June 1, 2023) average must be used.
5. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average in handicap tournament, whether originally submitted by the bowlers, the team, or others. Failure to use the correct average or make correction prior to completion of the first (1st) game shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than corrected average.
6. Entry fee is \$35.00 per person per event and \$5.00 for All Events (handicap); (\$20.00 for Optional Singles/\$10.00 Re-Entry). Alibi entry fee is \$20.00. Entry application must be accompanied by entry fee. No pre-entry fee returned after **JUNE 17, 2023.**
7. All tournament awards will be based on handicap scores except Special Awards. Handicap will be 80% of 210. Handicap will be figured individually for each bowler. In event of mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the bowler affected shall be moved to the next available lanes in the establishment at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Prize fee will be returned 100% in the event for which it is collected. PRIZE RATIO: 1:8 At least (1) prize for every EIGHT (8) entries.
8. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse any entrant's participation in the tournament. The Tournament Director further reserves the right to disqualify any entrant not in compliance with the rules of the tournament or USBC. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom including, but not limited to fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of the Tournament shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of tournament. All decisions of the Tournament Director are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC, Rule 329. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler at anytime during the tournament. **ALL RULES NOT COVERED BY THE AFOREMENTIONED, SHALL BE GOVERNED BY USBC.**
